

Mad River Watch Site Profile

WARREN FALLS

Site Coordinates: [44.093869, -72.864471](#)

Site Location Description: Warren Falls on the Mad River mainstem, 0.9 miles south of Lincoln Gap Rd. on the western side of Route 100.

Parking and Access: Parking area on the west side of Route 100. Do not follow the trail to Warren Falls or to the observation platform. Access is on a trail directly west of the parking lot. Walk to the right of the blue and white handicap access sign down the trail directly to the river.

Sampling Location: On eastern side of the Mad River above the main Warren Falls area and below the platform area.

Ease of Access: Short walk and easy access.

Parameters Measured: Temperature, Conductivity, pH

Riparian Buffer Description: Forested on both sides of the river with intense human use on the eastern bank. Several trails meander through the forest between the platform and the main falls area. Exposed rock along the river and loose rock/sand on the opposite bank.

Naturalist Notes (Ecology, History, Wildlife, Plant Species, etc.): Mixed deciduous/coniferous forest, Red-eyed vireo, Ovenbird, Veery.

Other Comments: This is a high use area for summer recreation.
