

**Mad River Watch Site Profile**

**WABENAKI CONSERVATION AREA**

**Site Coordinates:** 44.141417, -72.844806

**Site Location Description:** Wabenaki Conservation Area, Warren, west side of Route 100, between Sugarbush Access Road and Airport Road. Near access to Sugarbush snowmaking pond.

**Parking and Access:** Park at the first pull out on the right. There will be a sign for the Wabenaki Conservation Area. Follow the gravel pathway to the Mad River and towards the bridge.

**Sampling Location:** When you reach the river, the path will turn right to go under the bridge. Don't go under the bridge. Turn left at the metal railing and walk through the grass and between a few small trees to the edge of the river. You are sampling below the bridge on the northwest side of the river.

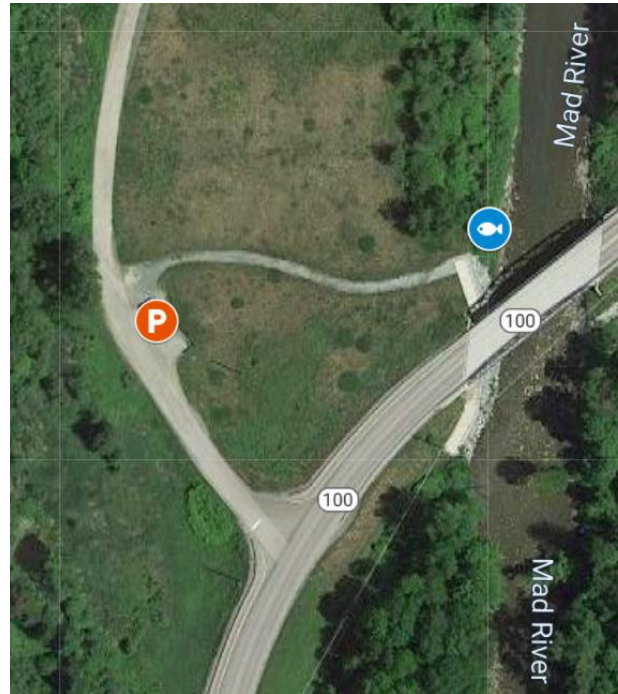
**Ease of Access:** Easy walk through grass and some woody vegetation.

**Analytes:** Temperature, conductivity, P, N


**Riparian Buffer Description:** Rocky banks under bridge, successional vegetation on northwest bank, Japanese knotweed on northwest bank, sandy areas on northwestern shore.

**Naturalist Notes (Ecology, History, Wildlife, Plant Species, etc.):** Song sparrow, Belted kingfisher, honeysuckle sp., Japanese knotweed, raccoon tracks.
